

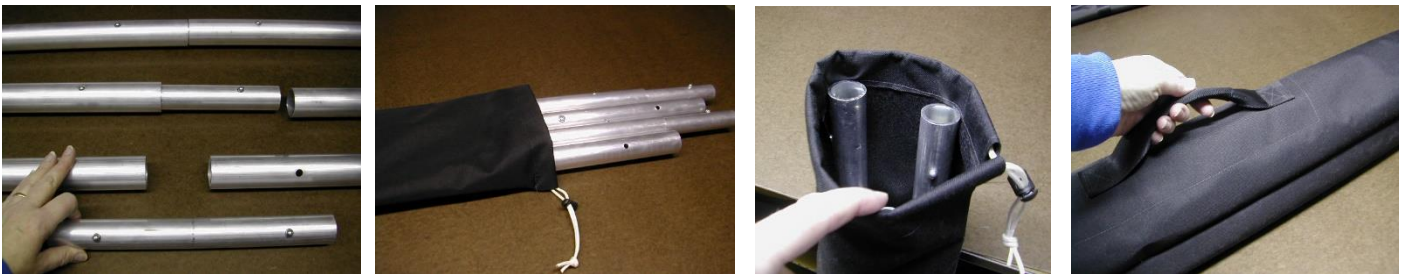
# Tuxedo Body Sled for Morticians by Caregivers Aide, LLC

## Optional Aluminum Poles Accessory

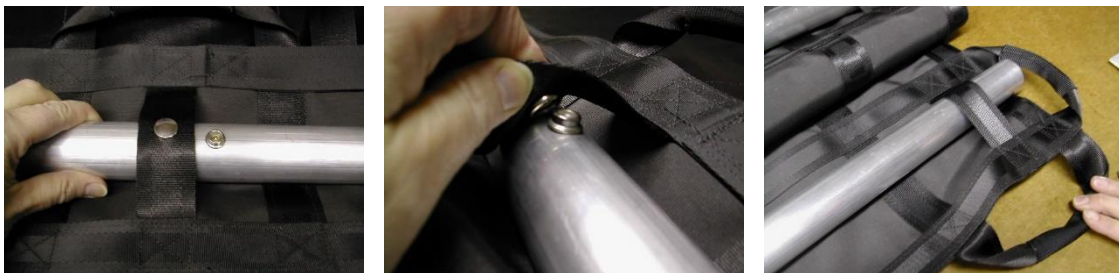
### Instructions:

Your Tuxedo has the option of having a pair of poles to help make it rigid when needed. The poles may be installed on each underside through webbing straps designed to allow their easy installation and removal. Each pole has two parts that connect by means of a third smaller pole that has push buttons to make the connection.

The poles are identical so are interchangeable with each other. You don't have to worry about getting the correct ends. They all fit. Once the smaller pole is inserted into a larger pole, it may remain there so you are not reassembling every time you want to use it. The carry bag will accommodate the longer length of having those 2 pieces remain together.



The poles may be inserted into place on the Tuxedo as one piece 6-foot-long or in halves.



The poles are snapped in place to keep them from shifting but are not required. You may decide to snap only one on each side. For going around corners or difficult maneuvers you may disengage the poles at their center, remove them, make the maneuver, then return them to position.

The poles make the Tuxedo rigid when you need for it to be so. It is not intended to use the poles as handles to move the body. The poles will be cumbersome to access when installed properly. The webbing handles are to be used with the poles adding support.
